We Fall Down

And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth shook and the rocks were split. Matthew 27:51

At the dawn of Creation, God intended for Adam and Eve and their descendants to live in perfect communion with Him. He desired to walk among them and do life with them as a father with his children, but Adam and Eve fell. If you're still craving intimacy with God, my hope is you will read these words and allow them to swell in your heart as a prayer of praise and thanksgiving for Jesus - the one who gave his life, so that we can live in the fullness of communion with God.
